Please be advised that the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Callander passed the following motion of support as part of its consent agenda at the Regular Council Meeting held on June 22, 2021:

WHEREAS municipalities have never been responsible for gun control laws in Canada;

AND WHEREAS law abiding Callander residents who own legal handguns have already been thoroughly vetted through the CFSC, PAL and ATT applications;

AND WHEREAS illegal gun owners and smugglers do not respect postal codes;

AND WHEREAS if one municipality enacts a ban and not a neighbouring municipality, this will create a patchwork of by-laws;

AND WHEREAS a municipal ban would be difficult to enforce and easy to get around;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Municipality of Callander has received a request for support of the Town of Kingsville Resolution: 205-2021, passed at its Regular Meeting held on March 8, 2021;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that The Corporation of the Municipality of Callander is OPPOSED to the adoption of any by-laws restricting the possession, storage and transportation of legally obtained handguns.
