THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF KINGSVILLE

BY-LAW 023 - 2022

Being a By-law to extend the period of time during which Interim Control By-law 42-2021 will be in effect

WHEREAS on May 10, 2021, Council for the Town of Kingsville passed Interim Control By-law 42-2021 pursuant to Section 38(1) of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. P.13, as amended, to provide the Town with the necessary time to complete a secondary plan study and allow Council to consider the results of the study;

AND WHEREAS Section 38(2) of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.P.13, as amended, authorizes the council of the municipality to amend an interim control by-law to extend the period of time during which it will be in effect, provided the total period of time does not exceed two years from the date of the passing of the interim control by-law;

AND WHEREAS Interim Control By-law 42-2021 will expire on May 10, 2022 if not further extended by Council;

AND WHEREAS additional time is required to complete and review the secondary plan study;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF KINGSVILLE ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- Interim Control By-law 42-2021 is hereby amended by deleting paragraph 6 and replacing it with "This by-law shall be extended from May 10, 2022 and shall remain in effect for a further one (1) year period ending on May 10, 2023 in accordance with subsection 38(2) of the Planning Act, unless repealed by Council at an earlier date".
- 2. This amending by-law shall come into force and take effect on the day it is finally passed.
