

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF KINGSVILLE

BY-LAW 11 - 2023

Being a by-law to appoint members to the Kingsville Police Services Board

WHEREAS the *Police Services Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. P.15*, Section 27(1) (the “Act”) states that there shall be a police services board for every municipality that maintains a police force;

AND WHEREAS Section 27(4) states that the board of a municipality whose population does not exceed 25,000 shall consist of,

- a) the head of the municipal council or, if the head chooses not to be a member of the board, another member of the council appointed by resolution of the council;
- b) one person appointed by resolution of the council, who is neither a member of the council nor an employee of the municipality; and
- c) one person appointed by the Lieutenant Governor in Council.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF KINGSVILLE ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. **THAT** the following members of Council and individuals are appointed to the Kingsville Police Services Board for the term commencing December 1, 2022 and appointments will remain in effect until new appointments are made:

2. This by-law shall come into force and take effect on the date it is finally passed.
