BY-LAW 41 - 2023

Being a By-law to Appoint an Alternate Member to the Council of the County of Essex during an absence of the Mayor or Deputy Mayor

WHEREAS Bill 68, *Modernizing Ontario's Municipal Legislation Act*, 2017 received Royal Assent on May 30, 2017, and amends the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, herein referred to as the "Act";

AND WHEREAS section 268(1) of the Act provides that the council of a local municipality may appoint one of its members as an Alternate Member to the upper-tier council, to act in place of a person who is a member of the councils of the local municipality and its upper-tier municipality, when the person is unable to attend a meeting of the upper-tier council for any reason;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF KINGSVILLE ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- That Councillor Tony Gaffan is hereby appointed as the Alternate Member to County Council for the term of the council ending November 14, 2026, or until this appointment by-law is rescinded or until such time as the Alternate Member's seat is declared vacant in accordance with section 259 of the Act.
- 2. That Councillor Thomas Neufeld is hereby appointed in the absence of the Alternate Member if the Alternate Member is unable to attend.
- 3. The Alternate Member(s) appointed herein shall not sit on behalf of the Mayor or Deputy Mayor at an Inaugural Meeting of Essex County Council.
- 4. That By-law 4-2019 is hereby repealed.
- 5. This by-law shall come into force on the day it is passed, and take effect on the day the Alternate Member takes the oath of office as administered by the County Clerk.
