THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF KINGSVILLE

BY-LAW 51 - 2023

Being a by-law to appoint a Drainage Superintendent pursuant to the Drainage Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.D.17 and a Weed Inspector pursuant to the Weed Control Act

WHEREAS section 9 of the *Municipal Act, 2001* S.O. 2001 c. 25 provides that a municipality has the capacity, rights, powers and privileges of a natural person for the purpose of exercising its authority under this or any other Act;

AND WHEREAS section 93 of the *Drainage Act* R.S.O. 1990, c. D.17 provides that a municipal council may appoint, by by-law, a drainage superintendent;

AND WHEREAS section 8(1) of the *Weed Control Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. W.5, provides that a municipal council may appoint, by by-law, a municipal weed inspector;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF KINGSVILLE ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- That LuAnn Marentette be and is hereby appointed as a Drainage Superintendent for The Corporation of the Town of Kingsville and shall carry out the duties imposed upon her pursuant to the Act and shall submit such reports and carry out such other duties as may be required of her by Council from time to time;
- 2. That LuAnn Marentette be and is hereby appointed as a Municipal Weed Inspector for The Corporation of the Town of Kingsville and shall carry out the duties imposed upon her pursuant to the *Weed Control Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. W.5
- 3. By-laws 3-2010, 15-2010, and 48-2013 are hereby repealed effective August 14, 2023.
- 4. This by-law shall come into force and take effect on the date it is finally passed.
