D. REPORTS

1. Monthly Status Reports

- i) Town of Kingsville PSB & Crime Stoppers report May 2023

Inspector Ferguson and Staff Sergeant Wilson presented an overview of the Town of Kingsville Monthly Status reports and responded to questions of the Board.

It was noted that mental health calls were not in the top calls for service in May. There was discussion re: need for mental health resources, and that there are opportunities to build access to mental health services within the community.

There were questions re: foot patrol hours and the time of the patrols. For the August meeting, Inspector Ferguson and Staff Sergeant Wilson will check the report/summary to determine if the time of the patrols can be determined and will also report back on the calls related to the number of insecure premises.

4. Update- OPP MCRT Enhancement Grant

5. C.C.T.V. Grant

The Board requested that Administration look into available grants and bring back to PSB for discussion.

6. Speeding

The Police Services Board and the O.P.P. to determine their top five priority areas for speeding in the Town of Kingsville. There are chronic traffic areas for speeding – Road 3 E and Road 2 E are among the top, and there are very few calls within the Town limits.

There was a discussion about the rotation of the speed trailer, residential limitations and the utilization of other tools. The PSB will send an email to Staff Sergeant Wilson re: streets for the speed trailer.
