# 3. July Kick-Off Events

The committee debriefed the Fantasy of Lights Christmas in July event held at the Open Streets on July 29, 2023.

The Fantasy of Lights committee agreed they need a greater level of support at a Christmas in July via volunteers or choose a selection of activities that the committee could operate independently.

The most popular event was the Kingsville Express and Children's Activities, but next year, have more Christmas-themed items. The popcorn was a successful treat, a total of 200 bags were given out and they were gone in half-an-hour.

#### 4. Artisan Market

There are 23 vendors so far for the Christmas Artisan Marketplace, as of September 18, 2023.

L. Pittendreigh is vetting the vendors to ensure there's no competition between the vendors. L. Pittendreigh is reaching out to service groups to see if they can provide food items during the Christmas Artisan Marketplace.

### 5. Parade

The new parade route was approved by council on August 12, 2023. There are currently 15 participants registered.

G. Willemsma asked if the Fantasy of Lights committee would want to put a float into the Migration Fall Festival Parade. M. Edwards said she will see if she has access to a truck and trailer for the weekend and will let the committee know.



#### 6. Volunteers

The committee was informed they have 35 people who have indicated that they are interested in supporting the Santa Claus Parade but not yet confirmed.

### 7. Paws and Claus

Almost 50 vendors were contacted to be a part of the Paws and Claus marketplace. So far, eight responded and six filled out their registration form. Santa Claus is booked for the event and a photographer has been arranged.
