



How long have you lived in Kingsville?



Q2 Generally speaking, how happy are you with life in Kingsville?



There are lots of stop signs where there could be yeilds; lots of intersections which have no lines of sight across the intersection (park and lakeview is a prime example). Instead of running trucks up lakeview ave. to wigle (with a corner that many trucks cannot navigate without taking the entire road), extend industry road through the (not yet developed!) field to the north to main, with an intersection sized for 53' trailers; and then disallow truck traffic on the rest of lakeview ave. The harbour in-town would be better used for pleasure craft, with mixed residential/commercial properties along the south side of park. The kingsville marina is so far out of town that it discourages tourism by boat, and that harbour is only suitable in fair weather due to it's limited breakwater and shallow channel. Given that Kingsville's logo is a sailboat on the water, the absence of facilities for sailboats to visit is notable.

Too many handshakes from the past are stopping us from moving forward in a fiscally responsible way. Ensure full accountability with a process that can be tracked in the future - leases, rental agreements etc. It's time to move on with a "moderated" solution for those agreements that happened before. - Support our not-for profit organizations. I know there are community grants to apply for but we have community organizations meeting in buildings all over the municipality and locking in those building spaces. We have an arena and community centre with meeting spaces (as one example) that could serve many community groups for that purpose. Not-for-profits can pay rent to the town which supports those in need and also helps to address the



fiscal issue at hand. That rent should cover the cost to run the building, not to make a profit. It's a win-win. - I don't understand why council needs a new meeting place. The one we have has met the needs for decades. I can see in the future if the municipal office were to be relocated, but now? Even if a new space is truly needed, we have buildings with plenty of it already - the Grovedale as one example. Why move into an entirely vacant building that could be bringing in a rental fee (Unico)?




Q6 How important are these priorities to you?






