THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF KINGSVILLE BY-LAW 67-2024

Being a By-law to Appoint a Member to the Kingsville Municipal Heritage Advisory Committee

WHEREAS Sections 8 and 9 of the *Municipal Act, 2001* S.O. 2001 c. 25, as amended, (the "Act") provides that a municipality has the capacity, rights, powers and privileges of a natural person for the purpose of exercising the authority conferred upon a municipality to govern its affairs as it considers appropriate;

AND WHEREAS the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c.25, Subsection 23.1 authorizes a municipality to delegate powers and duties to a person or body;

AND WHEREAS The Council of the Corporation of the Town of Kingsville wishes to appoint a member to the Kingsville Municipal Heritage Advisory Committee (the "Committee"), pursuant to Section 28(1) of the *Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990*, c. O.18 (the "Act");

AND WHEREAS Section 28(2) of the Act states that the Committee shall be composed of not fewer than five (5) members appointed by Council;

AND WHEREAS the Committee has been reduced to four (4) members total due to a recent resignation;

AND WHEREAS The Council of the Corporation of the Town of Kingsville deems it appropriate and expedient to appoint a person to the Committee.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF KINGSVILLE ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That Carol Sitler be appointed to the Kingsville Municipal Heritage Advisory Committee.
- 2. That the term of appointment shall run concurrently with Council's current term of office (2022-2026) and until such time that successors are appointed.
- 3. This By-law comes into full force and takes effect on the day of the final passing thereof.
