RE: No. 47 Drain – North Branch of the East Branch
Realignment for Intersection Improvements

RECOMMENDED ACTION

That report prepared by Rood Engineering, dated December 23, 2024, on the No. 47 Drain – N Branch of the East Branch for a realignment of a portion of the drain for the Intersection of County Road 29 and Road 5 improvements, pursuant to Section 78 of the Drainage Act, **BE ADOPTED.**

BACKGROUND

Staff received a request from the Road Authority, Tim Del Greco of the Town of Kingsville to realign a portion of the municipal drain to improve the intersection of County Road 29 and Road 5. Rood Engineering was then appointed to create the report.

DISCUSSION

The Engineer has provided his report dated December 23, 2024. A portion of the drain needed to be realigned to have a better configuration at the intersection therefore the report provides for same. The owner of the farmland at roll #410-06100 has been involved with the report and an 8m x 20m strip of land has been taken to accommodate this realignment.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS

The owner of roll # 410-06100 will be entitled to an allowance and damages in the amount of \$809.00.

Total estimated cost of the engineering is \$5,701.00.

Note: Construction has already happened through the County of Essex contract.

ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS

Report sent to ERCA for review and comments. The permit application and fee was included in the County of Essex contract.
