

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF KINGSVILLE

BY-LAW 32 - 2025

Being a By-law authorizing the execution of a Transfer Payment Agreement with His Majesty the King, as represented by the Minister of Infrastructure (the “Province”) and The Corporation of the Town of Kingsville

Whereas Section 9 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c.25 confers natural person powers on municipalities which include the power to enter into agreements with individuals and corporations;

And Whereas the Municipal Housing Infrastructure Program (“MHIP”) – Housing Enabling Core Servicing Stream (“HECS”) is an application-based Transfer Payment Agreement that funds projects aimed at the development, repair, rehabilitation, and expansion of municipal roads and bridges to promote growth and enable housing for growing and developing communities;

And Whereas The Corporation of the Town of Kingsville (the “Town”) made application to the Province for funding for an infrastructure project (the “Project”) that will enhance roads, promote growth, and enable housing;

And Whereas the Town has been notified by the Province that it will receive up to \$7,437,500.00 in funding for the subject Project through the MHIP-HECS;

And Whereas the Town deems it expedient to enter into a Transfer Payment Agreement (“Agreement”) with the Province in order to participate in the MHIP-HECS;

Now therefore The Council of The Corporation of The Town of Kingsville enacts as follows:

1. **That** the Mayor and the Acting Clerk be and they are hereby authorized and empowered on behalf of The Corporation of the Town of Kingsville, to execute a Transfer Payment Agreement with His Majesty the King in right of Ontario as represented by the Minister of Infrastructure, dated this 5th of May, 2025, a copy of which Agreement is attached hereto and forms part of this By-law and to do such further and other acts which may be necessary to implement said Agreement.
2. **That** this By-law comes into force and takes effect on the day of final passing thereof.

Read a first, second and third time and finally passed this 5th day of May 2025.
