Splash Pad can't be located at Mettawas Park due to gravel dust. Pickleball can enhance the community. It is more than a game it is a community builder.

Children love pickleball as well and this sport can grow into an all ages sports.

Green space at back of property is for memorial space  
Rain Shelter and shade will be needed  
Ron Koudy's noted that 8-10 pickleball courts could be allocated to the current site where the basketball courts is.  
Can Pickleball courts be done first, as there is a need for more? Pickleball group may be asked to fundraise to assist in this  
Basketball court could be very noisy  
Is there an opportunity for partnership with the school board for a nature play area?  
There is already a group that is willing to donate toward the Basketball courts  
ACCESS needs input with respect to their community garden in this design.
