AIM

BACKGROUND

Over the past two years Council and Administration have been provided with information regarding concerns from the residents of the Cedar Beach area have had regarding the operation of the marina and boat launch. This was brought forward to strategic planning input sessions and the importance of the waterfront was reinforced through this process.

- Selection of Communication Plans
- Creation of the Schedule

- Identify Roles and Responsibilities

This plan will be brought back to Council for review and input. Once the plan is approved the Committee with set up at least two public sessions with communications that were brought forth through the kick off meeting.

It is anticipated that the project will be completed for Council presentation no later then July 2017.
